

Procedure for Test Re-Assessments: Anatomy & Physiology

All students will have the opportunity for test retakes following a unit test. In order to be able to do a reassessment on a unit, a student will need to seek help for review and relearning prior to the retest. Please refer to the details below and speak with your teacher if you have questions.

Retake Policy:

- It is required that the student will seek **at least one intervention opportunity** (2nd Period, Science Resource Center, or other arrangements with the teacher) in order to help them achieve a higher score.
- The student will have two weeks from the day the test was handed back to re-assess.
- A student can re-take a test as many times as he/she would like within 2 week time frame and the highest score will be put into Skyward.
- This procedure will not apply to students that receive a zero due to an unexcused absence or an academic integrity violation.

Useful Information:

- You have to complete a re-take during one period. You are NOT allowed to start a re-take and then finish at a later time.
